



SCHOLARSHIPS

Trinity Lutheran College offers a range of scholarships for students from 1 to year 10. Applicants must exhibit the attitudes and attributes of an allround learner, demonstrate exemplary behaviour and work habits and be prepared to uphold the Christian values of the College.

Group A: Open to current students of Trinity Lutheran College continuing at the College in 2018

1. Level 1: Academic Scholarship for students progressing into years 6, 7, 8 and 9, with one awarded per eligible year level
 - The applicant must currently demonstrate a high level of achievement in the core curriculum areas including english, mathematics, science and humanities.
2. Level 2: Sports Secondary Scholarship for students progressing into year 7 with one awarded
 - The applicant must demonstrate all round sporting ability, commendable sportsmanship and potential for sports leadership.
3. Level 2: Spirit of Learning Scholarship with one awarded to a primary student and one awarded to a secondary student as per year level in 2018
 - The applicant must demonstrate a love of learning and a preparedness to engage with the 4 C's of 21st century learning – critical thinking, creativity, collaboration and communication.
4. Level 4: Music Scholarship
 - The applicant must be currently studying a musical instrument for at least 12 months and be eligible to be part of the instrumental ensemble program.
 - The scholarship provides tuition in the selected instrument for one year.

Group B: Open to students not currently enrolled at the College but who wish to be in 2018

5. Level 1 and Level 3: Academic Scholarships for students entering year 7
 - The applicant must currently demonstrate a high level of achievement in the core curriculum areas including english, mathematics, science and humanities.
6. Level 1 and Level 3: Spirit of Learning Scholarships for students entering years 1 to 8
 - The applicant must demonstrate a love of learning and a preparedness to engage with the 4 C's of 21st century learning – critical thinking, creativity, collaboration and communication.
7. Level 2: Sports Scholarship for students entering year 7 with one awarded
 - The applicant must demonstrate all round sporting ability, commendable sportsmanship and potential for sports leadership.
8. Level 3: Music Scholarship for students entering year 7 with one awarded
 - The applicant must be currently studying a musical instrument for at least 12 months and be eligible to be part of the instrumental ensemble program.
 - Music tuition in the selected instrument is also provided for one year.

Group C: Open to any student either currently enrolled at Trinity Lutheran College or not currently enrolled but who wishes to be. Applicants must be a baptised and active member of Holy Trinity Lutheran Church Mildura.

9. Level 1: Holy Trinity Lutheran Church Scholarship for secondary students with a priority to students entering year 7. Other year levels will only be considered should there be no eligible year 7 applicants.
10. Level 4: Tschirpig Secondary Scholarship for students moving into years 8, 9 or 10. The value of the scholarship is determined each year by the donor.

There are four levels of scholarships:

- Level 1 is 50% tuition for 12 months
- Level 2 is 25% tuition for 12 months
- Level 3 is 25% tuition for 3 years
- Level 4 is where the value is specific to the scholarship.

A scholarship may be discontinued should academic effort and student behaviour be considered unsatisfactory.

Application process

1. The application process takes place during Term 2 of each year.
2. Scholarship Application Forms are available upon request from the Registrar, Mrs Gill Roberts.
3. The application is to be completed as fully as possible and all documents listed in the checklist must be submitted with the application.
4. Applications must be submitted by the advertised due date.
5. The 2017 due date for applications is 4pm Friday 16 June with interviews planned for Saturday 24 June.
6. Applicants will be short listed and notified of the status of their application and any interview details.
7. The interview panel will consist of the Principal and another member of the College leadership team. For specific scholarships, a specialist in that area may also be present. Family members of any applicant will not be eligible to sit on the selection panel.
8. Offers will be made to successful applicants by the start of term 3.
9. Successful applicants will be asked to accept in writing the terms and conditions of being awarded a Trinity Lutheran College scholarship.
10. New students will complete an enrolment form which will need to be returned at the same time as the letter of acceptance.

Application Checklist

- Completed scholarship application form
- Copy of final school report from the previous year
- Copy of the latest NAPLAN test results

Interview Checklist

A portfolio of achievement is to be brought to the interview. It can be electronic or hard copy. It is to include at least:

- A sample of work that the applicant enjoyed completing and that the applicant can talk confidently about
- A sample of work that demonstrates the applicant's creativity or problem solving ability
- A sample of a writing task completed by the applicant
- Any certificates or awards from the past 12 months
- Music scholarship applicants will be required to perform a piece on their selected instrument.
